ITINERARY - Family with Families Tour

PRE-EXTENSION TOUR

Day 1 - Benvenuti in Italia!

- Arrive the eternal City of Rome
- Meet your Tour Directors after customs and collecting your luggage
- Board your private transportation and head to Sorrento. The trip takes about 3.5 hours, along winding cliffsides and breathtaking views.
- We will check in and unwind at our hotel, then wander the city.

Day 2 - Positano

The first approach of this tour is to the hill side "S.Pietro" near Sorrento where the inlaid mountain winding road of the Amalfi coast begins and the scenery blends green countryside, steep cliffs, and crystal-clear sea.

After several photo stops, the first village where you can stroll and walk around is the "vertical" Positano and its hundreds staircases with shops of local products and crafts.



After leaving Positano, we will drive through the town of Praiano and Conca dei Marini where you can't miss the chance to see the Emerald Grotto, and the underwater ceramic nativity scene.

At mid-day, Amalfi is on the list, a town with a long background history which dates back to the first century A.C. It was also one of the four Maritime Republics of Italy as well as the first to introduce paper to Europe. In the town center stands the cathedral dedicated to Saint Andrew (Peter's apostle brother) that you can visit.



Last but not least Ravello and Villa Rufolo, in whose magnificent gardens the composer Richard Wagner found the inspiration for one of his greatest operas, the Parsifal. For this reason, Ravello hosts during the spring-summer season dozens of concerts under the name Ravello Festival. One more interesting place is Villa Cimbrone located at the highest point of the town where you can look out from the "infinity terrace" across Salerno. We will return to Sorrento for dinner with views of the sea.

Day 3 - Capri

This morning we will take the ferry from Sorrento to the Isle of Capri!

First we will take a boat ride Capri to admire the highlights:

The Faraglioni sea stacks, Punta Carena lighthouse, Villa Malaparte, Natural Arch
Visit the Grotta Meravigliosa, Grotta Bianca, Grotta Verde, and Blue Grotto along the coastline
Return to port after 1 hour and 45 minutes

Next we will take the funicular up to the town of Capri where we can enjoy lunch. We can wander the streets until we reach Anacapri, the top village of Capri. We will take the seggiovia to the tippy top of the island to take in amazing views of the Mediterranean Sea, and enjoy a glass of Prosecco. In the afternoon we will return down to the port, and take the ferry back to Sorrento.



Day 4 - Pompei

We will check out of our Sorrento hotel this morning. Our private transfer will take us to Pompeii, and our private Guide will give us a tour of the archaeological site. Pompeii is one of the most visited archaeologic sites in Europe and attracts the lion's share of tourists visiting southern Italy.

Pompeii had about 20,000 residents when it was completely buried by the ash and pumice stones created by the eruptions of Mount Vesuvius in 79 A.D.. Excavations of the site began during the 17th century and are still being carried on today to discover the many treasures and buildings still buried.



In the afternoon, we will continue on to our hotel in Rome. After we check in, we can wander the streets and enjoy dinner together in the Eternal City.
